

First Aruban Art Biennale Encounter of Contemporary Caribbean Art starting in the fall

The local Fundacion Encuentro Prome Bienal di Aruba, an initiative of award-winning contemporary artist Alida Martinez and art collector Roly Sint Jago, was recently set up to organize a multi-tiered event scheduled to take place from November 2011 to June 2012. Featuring exhibitions, lectures, workshops, and seminars, the event will serve as a platform for local art lovers, Caribbean artists, art critics, art teachers, and the international press to cross-pollinate the regional art scene. Cuban curator Jose Manuel Noceda Fernandez, on loan from the famous and well-established Art Biennale in Cuba, is at the helm of the artistic effort. He is the curator of Centro de Arte Contemporaneo Wilfredo Lam in Havana Vieja, and he is recognized within international art circles for his strong leadership and profound knowledge.
